

## **International Day of Co-operatives Address**

## Dear fellow co-operators,

On behalf of Euro Coop please accept our warmest wishes for a successful and co-operative year on the occasion of International Co-operative Day!

The theme of this year's **#CoopsDay** is **"Co-operatives for Decent Work"**. It was chosen in view of increasing inequality, job insecurity and unemployment, especially among young people, and taking into account UN Sustainable Development Goal 8 - "Decent Work and Sustainable Economic Growth".

As people-oriented enterprises that base their economic activities on values, co-operatives play an important role in



creating decent jobs and strengthening local communities socially and economically. This year we celebrate the 175th anniversary of the Pioneers of Rochdale. The principles they developed, which still guide the work of consumer co-operatives around the world today, are based in particular on the ideas of Robert Owen. We are proud that the co-operative contribution has been recognised by the International Labour Organisation (ILO).
